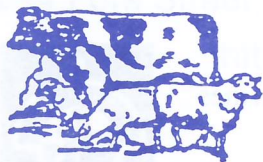

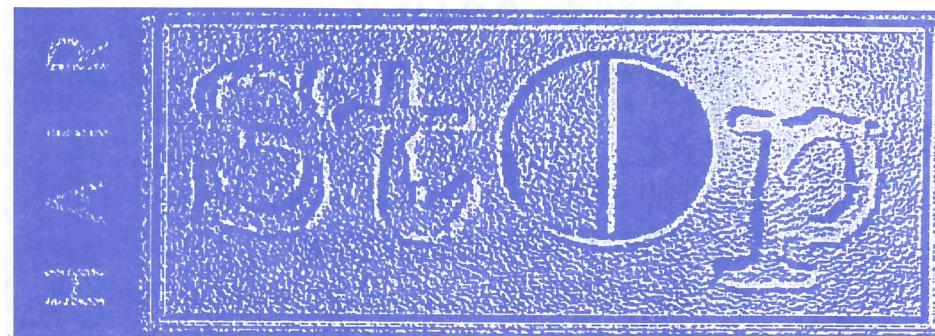

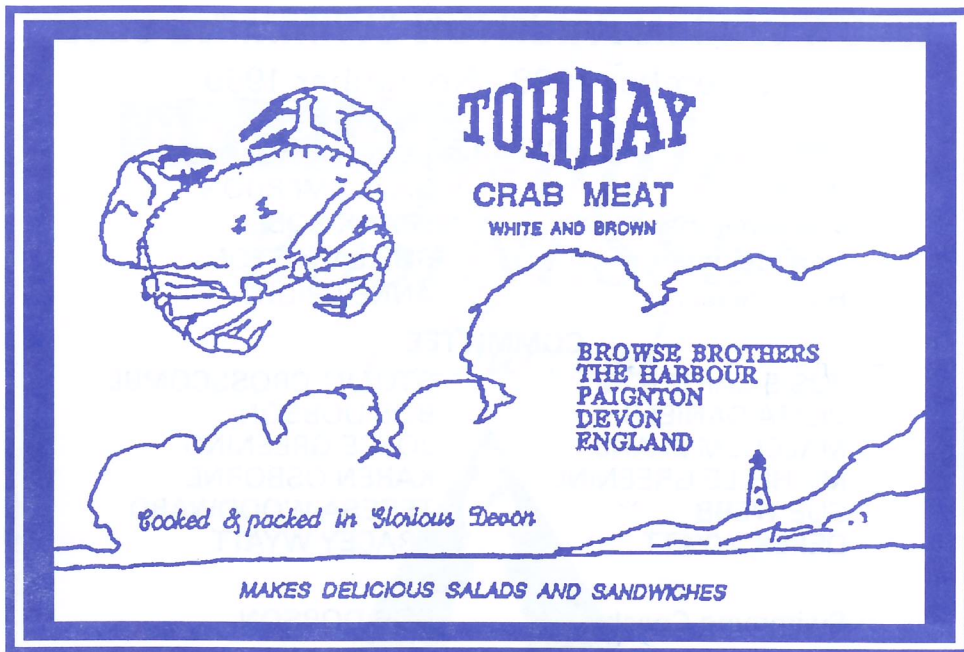

If swimmers are not available at the time their event is **called** they will miss their event.

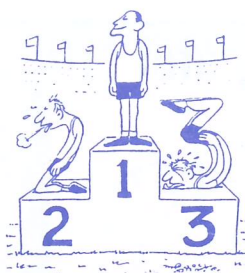
