During 1988 to 1989 we have once more placed prominence in affording water time towards the achieving of A.S.A. Survival Awards.

The A.S.A. Awards Scheme were first introduced in a rudimentary introductory form in 1952 since when they have undergone a number of additions and modifications. The Personal Survival Awards introduced in 1962 proved popular both with Education Authorities and Swimming Clubs and were followed by Rainbow Distance Awards, Water Skills Awards and Waterpolo and Synchro - swimming Awards.

The whole Scheme was again re-vamped in March of 1988 to reflect the latest research into cold water survival and has since proved quite successful.

As a Club we shall continue with the Swimming Challenge Awards which cater for most ages and abilities. Unfortunately the very high cost of water hiring prohibits the expansion of our activities in this field.
