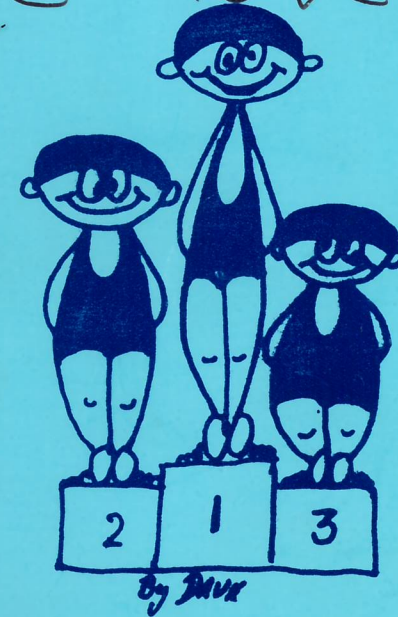

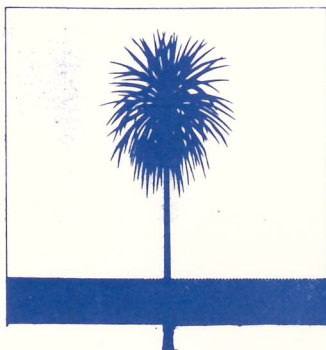

Congratulations to twelve year old Emma Davies, Paignton Swimming Club's young breaststroke star. She gained eighth place and swam the sixth fastest time in England, her personal best. This was a really great achievement, swimming in an unfamiliar 50 metre pool, having trained in our smaller 33 1/3rd metre pool and facing such formidable competition. Well done Emma.

From National swimming we go to Devon County level, where many of our swimmers competed and did very well. Eighteen of our swimmers represented the Club in the finals.

Our Water Polo Squad have had a good season. The under 14s were division champions, getting gold medals and the under 18s finished in silver medal slot. Here again, a youngster from the Club is actively coaching a squad, in this case its Derren Westacott, who is taking the under fourteens.

The William's Shield is back in Paignton's hands again, having been in Brixham for many years. Its a spectacular looking trophy, awarded for the young swimmers' events, lets keep it in Paignton's trophy cabinet, a good omen for the years to come.

Well, back to tonight, the message has to be simply, "Enjoy your swimming and keep on coming"!

### PERSONAL SURVIVAL AND LIFE-SAVING

Ever since its inception in 1900 this Club has been committed to a long standing tradition of concentrating a part of its activities upon the teaching of the above disciplines. Whilst the cost of Pool Hire has constantly risen, which has adversely affected the time we can devote to these awards, nevertheless we shall endeavour to continue to provide this important alternative to regular swimming training.

It is comforting to note that, by a recent Government ruling, all schools are now obliged to include swimming in their curriculum.

Another subject which has been prominent of late is the recommendation by the A.S.A. that the teaching of diving into water of less depth than 1 metre is dangerous. It is now our policy not to teach diving into the two shallow Pool Ends. Only at supervised Galas will diving be permitted at the start and finish ends by suitably experienced competition swimmers.

The Club is especially indebted to Brian Pearce who has so ably organised and conducted this aspect of our sport.

This included a very educational visit to an East German town named Quedlinburg which was of especial interest since they are only just emerging from the neglect and shortages arising from 40 years of Russian domination.

The second visit, when we welcomed the Hamelin Group to Paignton, took place in October and has been claimed by the Hamelin Leaders as 'the best yet'. Many new friendships were forged during their stay and older ones re-established.

The work involved in organising these Exchange Visits is extensive, starting some three months in advance and culminating in a frantic week of trips and competitions. We therefore extend our grateful thanks to Dave Smerdon who has so diligently dealt with this heavy burden and come up smiling.

We also register our heartfelt thanks to all of our English Host Families who have contributed so much to the success of these Visits and without whose help we could not even contemplate continuing .... and all on a voluntary basis too !!

The next visit to Hamelin will be in October 1993 ... so start saving your pennies now.
